

Pit Requirements

1. Only the driver and the car enters for the registration fee. You will receive a special pit pass for your entrance into the pit area. **A pit pass will be required for anyone other than the driver. A pit pass will cost \$20.00 to enter the pit area. The pit pass will be enforced and monitored.**
2. No children under the age of 16 are allowed in the pit area unless participating in the event. **(because of insurance requirements)**
3. All cars must be removed by 10:00 PM on the day of the event. It is your responsibility to remove your car from the pit area.
4. Consumption or possession of alcohol or other illegal substances is not allowed in the pit area and is automatic cause for disqualification. **(this will be checked and enforced by the local Sheriff Department)**
5. A waiver must be signed by all people in the pit area.

Racing Rule

1. Depending upon the number of contestants, there will be three heats. Your car will be assigned a heat by receipt of your application. Once assigned a heat, you cannot change. Upon entering the fairgrounds, please go to the assigned heat parking.
2. Depending upon the number of contestants, the last six cars operating in each heat will win the right to compete in the Feature. There may be a consolation heat if there is enough driver interest or enough for the car count.
3. Each driver will be given a lath marker which will be fastened to the driver's side door. When the driver is disqualified, the flag is broken by the driver. Drivers must remain in their vehicles until the heat is finished, unless a fire or any other disaster makes the vehicle unsafe.
4. Each car must initiate contact every 60 seconds or be disqualified.
5. If a warning signal is given, such a numerous flags waving or a loud siren sound, **ALL DRIVERS MUST STOP!** Pay close attention to this.
6. You may drive forward or backward, but avoid hitting the driver's side door. Violation of this rule is grounds for disqualification.
